↳ The Mobile Prayer Tour is a form of intercessory prayer that involves driving along a designated route in McKinney and praying for specific locations.

↳ The locations highlighted on the tour are a sampling of ministries, agencies, and organizations that serve and/or influence McKinney.

↳ Prayer-driving (and prayer-walking) around McKinney helps the body of Christ to actually see and hear the needs of our city and the people God has placed within its borders, and then pray for them as God leads.

## GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:

This GUIDE OFFERS FOUR VARIATIONS of the Mobile Prayer Tour: Drive-by Praying, All in One Praying, Praying from East to West, and Stop and Pray. This allows each group participating to customize their tour as needed.

## HOW TO USE THE GUIDE:

1. CHOOSE THE TOUR desired (see Table of Contents).
2. Turn to the INSTRUCTIONS for that tour. The instructions include a list of the designated stops and the approximate amount of time required for the tour.
3. The instructions are followed by an INFORMATIONAL PAGE for each designated stop. The information includes the location's number on the tour (corresponds to the McKinney Mobile Prayer Tour map), name, address, directions, the organization's ministry to McKinney, and prayer needs.
4. LET THE HOLY SPIRIT LEAD you as you drive and pray.
5. Remember to DRIVE SAFELY.
6. RESTROOMS are available at Old Settler's Park, City Hall, or MPAC.

## INSTRUCTIONS FOR DRIVE-BY PRAYING:

1. Covers all 18 locations on McKinney Prayer Tour Map.
2. Pray for each location as you drive-by, no stops.
3. Approximately **60 minutes**.
4. Option: stop and pray 5 minutes at each location—approximately 2—2 1/2 hours

## INSTRUCTIONS FOR ALL IN ONE PRAYING

1. Covers 7 stops on McKinney Prayer Tour Map.
2. Stop and pray 5-8 minutes at each location.
3. At each chosen location, include in your prayers similar agencies or organizations. See below.
4. Approximately **60-90 minutes**.

(include agencies that minister to McKinney's children & teens)

#3—Webb Elementary School  
(pray for education, McKinney schools)

#6—City Hall  
(include all government agencies, fire, police, military)

(include faith-based organizations and McKinney churches)

#10—Community Food Bank  
(include agencies that serve McKinney's poor and needy)

#11—McKinney Housing Authority  
(pray for all McKinney families)

## INSTRUCTIONS FOR PRAYING EAST TO WEST:

1. Covers stops along Louisiana/Virginia Parkway, from the east side of McKinney to the west.
2. Pray for each location as you drive by.
3. Pray for the unity of McKinney.
4. Approximately **30 minutes**.
5. Option—stop at each location and pray 5 min.—approximately 60 minutes.

## INSTRUCTIONS FOR STOP AND PRAY:

1. Covers 5 locations per section (dividing McKinney Prayer Tour map into 4 sections). See below.
2. Every week, month, or quarter drive to a different section.
3. Stop and pray 10-15 minutes at each location in that section.
4. Approximately **60-90 minutes**.

### Address:

Bumpas & Murray

### Directions:

From Hwy 5 (McDonald), drive east on Louisiana (Greenville), turn right on Murray. Stay on Murray (it zig zags) to Bumpas St.

### History / service to McKinney:

Low income housing. (Section 8: Govt. assistance)

### Prayer needs:

1. High crime rate (families fearful)
2. Marriages
3. Families / children
4. Leadership team: churches, Press Ele., police, LifePath owners, community services.
5. Place for service

## Old Settler's Park & Rec. Center

### Address:

1201 E. Louisiana St.

### Directions:

From Manor House drive north on Bumpas St., turn left on Anthony, right on Murray and right on Greenville. Left on Miller to park.

### History / service to McKinney:

Public Park: summer and after school programs for children and teens.

### Prayer needs:

1. Church and community programs for children
2. Safety
3. Volunteers / mentors
4. Christian influence through sports programs, Fun with the Son, etc.
5. Barney 'n Me Gym

*Call them all together—men, women, children, and the foreigners living in your towns (McKinney) (Deut. 31:12).*

## Webb Elementary School

### Address:

810 E. Louisiana St.

### Directions:

From Old Settler's Park proceed west on Greenville. School on south side.

### History / service to McKinney:

Represents McKinney elementary schools and educational needs of children.

### Prayer needs:

1. Teachers & staff
2. Children
3. Families
4. Adopt a School
5. After school programs

## Holy Family School

### Address:

500 Throckmorton

### Directions:

From Webb, drive west on Greenville turn right on Throckmorton. School on right side of street.

### History / service to McKinney:

3. Christian education
4. Funding
5. Surrounding neighborhood

2. Integrity and honor: heavy responsibility
3. Families: shift work, undercover, etc.
4. Marriage enrichment
5. High divorce rate

### Directions:

From fire station drive west on Hunt.

### History / service to McKinney:

Represents city, county, state, and federal governments.

### Prayer needs:

1. Elected & appointed officials (city, county, state, & federal), boards & commissions
2. Wisdom and knowledge
3. Fear of God
4. Godly decisions: policy, budget, ordinances
5. City planning decisions: development process
6. At build-out—largest city in Collin Co.

4. Freedom from bondages

From Samaritan Inn take sharp left and return on Church. (Pray for Job Corp as you drive by). Cross University and continue south on Church. Cross Louisiana to Finch Park.

Provides after school and summer programs for needy children in Collin Co.

### Prayer needs:

1. Children
2. Safe learning environment
3. After school programs
4. Volunteers—mentors—instructors—coaches
5. Children reach God-given potential
